As the first cantor of the largest and one of the oldest synagogues in south Texas, helped the congregation innovate in many ways, including the following:

### Worship Initiatives

- Created a Temple band to accompany worship services monthly and on select holidays
- Grow congregation steeped in classical Reform worship style to evolve, incorporating a wider variety of classical and contemporary compositions
- Recruit and train a substantial cadre of lay worship leaders
- Doubled volunteer choir participation for Shabbat and High Holy Days
- Initiated adult learning experiences within the context of the worship service to educate the congregation about liturgy
- Instituted the use of piano alongside and often in place of organ in an historic sanctuary with a large pipe organ that had been the primary instrumental accompaniment for more than 125 years
- Recruit and supervise accompanists and other instrumentalists

## Congregational Relationships

- Lead pastoral care initiative and coordinate ongoing pastoral efforts for all clergy
- Stabilized congregation during multiple years of instability and significant rabbinic transition
- Initiated program to connect with college students to maintain a relationship with congregation and its clergy throughout the year
- Oversee all aspects of annual Women's Seder

## Educational Programs

- Oversee B'nai Mitzvah program, including assigning dates, supervising B'nai Mitzvah tutor, teaching students, and leading service rehearsals
- Teach sixth grade Hebrew class in preparation for Bar/Bat Mitzvah studies
- Lead Religious School T'filah for various grades
- Teach music to preschool class on Sundays
- Teach Adult Education courses in Jewish music and chanting Torah
- Launched monthly Rosh Chodesh group for women to study and connect with other Jewish women
- Initiated monthly learning series for volunteer choir on Zoom during pandemic

### Cultural Initiatives

- Created Sunday Concert Series, inviting congregants of all ages to share their musical talents with the congregation
- Coordinate annual Shabbat Shirah program, inviting leading Jewish musicians as weekend Musicianin-Residence
- Created Summer Concert Series during the pandemic to support local professional musicians and to provide enrichment for our congregants
- Created Jewish Music Month learning series on Zoom during pandemic, featuring several distinguished Jewish musicians and culminating in a Saturday night Zoom concert with a well-known Jewish music group

## Community Collaborations

- Work in partnership with Music Minister at Antioch Baptist Church for annual MLK Shabbat exchange, teaching music together to volunteer choirs for a Shabbat service and a Church service
- Collaborated with Choir Director at St. Mark's Episcopal Church and Director of Youth Orchestras of San Antonio (YOSA) to present two performances of *Chichester Psalms* by Leonard Bernstein with participation of St. Mark's Choirs, Temple Beth-El volunteer choir and YOSA Philharmonic Orchestra
